Thesis Summary:
This thesis proposes UTML (Unified Transaction Modeling Language) as a high level transaction modeling language for the design of complex structured transactions of web applications and services. The language comprises a flexible and extensible transaction meta-model and a UML compatible notation system. It accommodates most of the existing transaction models as well as new ones according to the application's requirements. The final design can be exported into XML format providing thus the ability to directly describe transactional web services.
